What We Do:

- We will work with any family who needs special financial consideration but is willing to work or contribute to the academy in a meaningful way

Payment Policy:

Each month's tuition is due on the first class of the month. You may pay with check (payable to SonShine Academy), or through the Square Cash App, which is free to use. You are welcome to pay more than one month's tuition at a time. Please indicate the number of months on your envelope or check. There will be a \$25 charge for returned checks and you will be required to pay with cash or the Square Cash app in subsequent months.

Behavior Policy:

In order to maximize learning, class behavior needs to be orderly and respectful.

Class Expectations:

1. Please be on time so we can begin and use our class time efficiently.

2. Choir students need to bring their folders with music, pencil & colored pencils to each rehearsal.

3. Students are expected to practice at home to be prepared for each rehearsal.

4. Students are to encourage and support one another.

Dress Code:

Please dress modestly. Shorts and skirts should be fingertip length, no midsections should ever be visible Shirts, pants and shorts should not have any inappropriate words or pictures. If the director views something as inappropriate, she will ask the student not to wear it again. Please respectfully adhere to these requests.

Lyrical Class Attire:

Lyrical students should wear a black leotard, and dance tights, with either ballet shoes or lyrical sandals. A black or pink ballet skirt, or dance shorts must be worn during class, and hair needs to be pulled up into a bun or ponytail. Cover up shirts and pants/shorts should be worn over tights and leotard before and after class.

Theatrical/ Hip hop:

Hip hop students should wear pants or shorts that they can move in, and girls should wear a leotard under their shirts. Shoes worn should be jazz shoes or lyrical sandals for girls and socks or tennis shoes for boys.

Attendance Policy:

Excellent attendance to rehearsals is essential to preparing songs and dances well. It also allows everyone to enjoy the outreach opportunities to their fullest knowing their designated roles and parts. When outreach event dates are given please respond quickly with your availability, so the director can plan accordingly.
